Programs



Cub Scouting

A year-round, family friendly program designed for children in kindergarten through fifth grade (ages 5-10). Activities are used to achieve the aims of Scouting - citizenship training, character development and personal fitness.

SCOUTS

Scouts BSA

A program designed for young adults ages 11-18. Scouts BSA teaches responsible citizenship, character development and self-reliance through participation in a wide range of outdoor activities and educational programs.



Venturing

A high-adventure based program for young men and women between the ages of 14 and 20. Its purpose is to provide positive experiences to help youth mature and prepare them to become responsible adults.



Sea Scouts

A program for young men and women ages 14-20 that promotes better citizenship and improved members' boating skills through instruction and practice in water safety, boating skills, outdoor, social, service experiences, and knowledge of maritime heritage.



Exploring

A career development program for young men and women between the ages of 14 and 20. Exploring units have a focus on a single career field, such as police, fire/rescue, health, law, aviation and engineering.

Reaching for Tomorrow character development program equips all youth grades Pre-K through 12, including youth with special needs, with life skills to overcome life's challenges by providing grade-specific, character education and basic skills.




Scouting for Tomorrow


